Puzzles & Miniatures --- Internal or external puzzles



### Advance Scroll Saw -- Internal & Detail cutting

Internal Cutting—the correct order to cut objects that break easily – **The pine Trees**

Cutting Detailed Objects -- the process of cutting delicate projects --**Pheasant & Buffalo**

Clocks & Tree Ornaments –the process of planning, laying & cutting- **Horse, Angel & Heart**
