

## Idea Number 3      “Light It Up”

While I was in Branson on my April-May trip, I found that many people have difficulty seeing the bottom blade holder to install new blades. So this is what I have come up with to put some light on that procedure.



Rockler sells a LED light that has a magnet on the back.



I used round magnets and glued them to a 90 degree metal bracket.

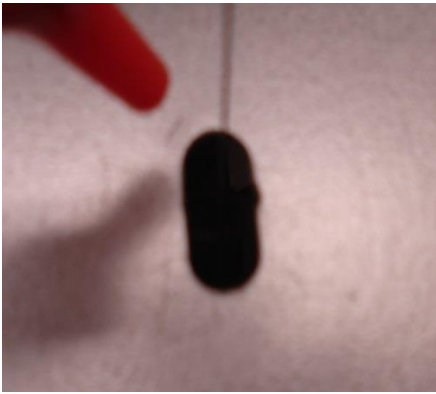
(I use 5 Min. Epoxy glue)



I could then place the magnetized light on the angle side of the bracket. I decided to mount it under the left side of the saw table.

***This can be easily done with the Excalibur saw, because the table does not tip as it does on most scroll saws.***

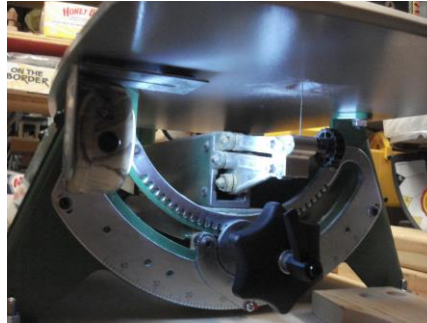
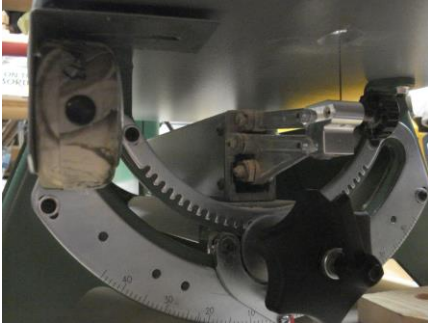
(The head tips instead)

Direct the light toward the blade holder, turn it on and

**"You Can See".**

**The total underside of the table is now illuminated.**

*No excuses now about not being able to see the blade holder assembly under the saw, or getting the blade in backwards etc.*

***This works great. It is not expensive to set up. You should be able to get all of the material for under \$10.00 at most any hardware store.***
